REVIEW

If you had to guess, what are some of the complications that have prevented them from understanding God's simple message. (Leader's note: There may be many answers. Remember we can be a stumbling block. The soul winner in a sense is a living advertisement of what Jesus Christ can do in a person's life. The unsaved may never read the Gospel According to John, but they will carefully examine the gospel

according to you. It's been said, "What you do speaks louder than what you say." Let's be a good testimony for the Lord.)

Homework

- Memorize John 3:16-17
- -Ask Jesus to give you and our church boldness in sharing His good news with everyone we know.
- -Ask God to reveal any way you have been avoiding sharing the Gospel. Then, ask for forgiveness and boldness.
- -continue in prayer
